

CONCERT DAY DOCK SPACE PROCEDURE

1. Limited dock space will be made available at North Beach for boaters to park their boats on Concert Days.
2. Lifeguards will hand out wristbands, by boat, to boaters sitting outside the Marina starting at 6:00AM on concert mornings.
3. Lifeguards will start calling out wristbands at approximately 6:15AM to permit orderly and safe parking of boats on the Administration/Courtesy dock, the dock closest to the concert stage.
4. Boaters who park their boat at the Admin Dock for the concert must leave their boat at the dock. LMVA will not 'save' the space for you.
5. Boaters who come only for the seating lottery may park their boat from 6AM – 8AM on the long, launch ramp dock, located at the south end of the marina.
6. Lifeguards will hold a second wristband lottery at 4:00PM, similar to the 6AM lottery to permit boaters to park on the Pedal Boat Dock for the concert.
7. Boaters participating in the 4:00PM Pedal Boat Dock lottery may alternately choose to select a posted available space at the end of the long Launch Ramp Dock.
8. Spots not taken during the lotteries may be taken on a first-come, first-served basis.
9. Boats may not double-park on the concert side of the Admin Courtesy Dock or the long Launch Ramp Dock for safety reasons.
10. Boats may tie off and double-park on the south side of the Courtesy Dock AND on either side of the Pedal Boat Dock.
11. Pontoon Boats are permitted to tie bow in in-lieu of parking side tied. No double parking in these cases.
12. Members may bring up to FOUR Guests.
13. The shore end of the long Launch Ramp Dock must remain open for launching and landing of boats.
14. The Maintenance Dock is not available for member boat parking. (Staff may permit a restroom stop of 10 minutes or less. Someone must remain with the vessel, with a staff member standing by. Boats parked more than 20 minutes are subject to citation.)
15. Coolers, chairs and other equipment may not be placed or stored on the docks.
16. Boats parked in posted No Parking areas are subject to citation mailed to the listed address.
