Picnic Table Reservations

Planning a picnic at North Beach? Twenty-two tables are available for reservation online or by visiting Lake Services. Reservations open one month in advance. Tables book quickly for summer weekends, so plan ahead! Additional tables are also available on a first-come, first-served basis.

Picnic Shelter Reservations

New this summer! Members may reserve space under one of the North Beach picnic shelters. The \$150 shelter reservations include 5 tables for a designated 6-hour block, exclusive use of a large barbecue grill, electrical outlets, and a 15-person guest list at no additional cost.

Make reservations starting one month in advance either online or by visiting Lake Services. Shelters are available on a first-come, first-served basis when not reserved, but must be vacated one hour prior to any standing reservation.



East Beach

For a more tranquil beach day, visit East Beach, currently open daily from 10:00 am-8:00 pm, with extended hours until 10:00 pm on July 4th and on concert Saturdays.

Enjoy the sandy beach, swim area, a snack bar that's open weekends and holidays, new play structure, and picnic tables.

Starting August 18, East Beach hours will be limited to weekends (and Labor Day) from 10:00 am-7:00 pm.

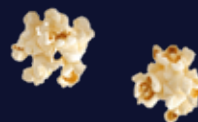

Be in the know

Do members need a ticket?

No, but a valid Lake ID badge is required for entry.

What about guests?

On concert days, each member-household may host up to 4 guests at North Beach for \$20 each. Guests must arrive with the member.

How do I reserve my spot?

Participate in the optional 6:00 am seating lottery. Please scan the QR code or use the link below to review lottery procedures before attending.

OR

Stop by the Lake the day of the concert, starting at 8:00 am, to place a blanket and chairs in any available spot.

What else do I need to know?

- Bring low beach chairs for seating.
- Blankets over 100 sq. feet and waterproof blankets/tarps are prohibited.
- Lottery participants may enter with a blanket only. Chairs and other items are permitted after completion of the lottery.
- Concert day guest pass prices apply all day for all guests at North Beach.
- No glass, personal barbeque grills, pets, or smoking permitted.
- Tents or canopies must be down by 6:00 pm.
- A drop-off zone is available before, during, and after concerts, even after the parking lot fills.
- Seating and parking are available for disabled or mobility-impaired guests.

HELPFUL REMINDERS



Lake ID Badges

Remember to bring your Lake ID badge each time you visit, regardless of your reason for stopping by, or a \$10 refundable replacement badge/temporary access fee will be charged. Badges are not transferable.

Guests

Each member-household can host up to 15 guests per day. On concert days, the number of guests at North Beach is limited to 4 per household at a cost of \$20 per guest. East Beach still allows up to 15 guests. Members must be on-site with their guests.

Advance guest lists may be made online. Lists made on the day of guests' visit must be done at Lake Services. Member must arrive before their guests and ask the gate staff to activate the list.

Guest Fees

- **General Admission:** \$5.00 per guest | day
- **Guests of Members Ages 62+:** \$2.50 per guest | day
- **Children Under 8:** Free
- **Concert Day Pass:** \$20 per guest | day | all ages (limit of 4 per member-household)



To keep the Lake safe and clean, pets and glass containers are prohibited on Lake property and rental watercraft.

DELEGATE ELECTIONS Your Vote Matters

Did you know that neighborhoods in the Lake Mission Viejo Association are represented by delegates who vote for the Lake's Board of Directors?

Homeowners in neighborhoods not part of another neighborhood HOA elect these delegates via ballots mailed with the July assessment reminder. Those receiving e-statements can access their ballot on the member portal. If you haven't already done so, please complete and return your ballot. It's important to vote – even if just for quorum purposes.

Anyone who can't access their ballot online or can't find a mailed ballot can request a copy by emailing ballot@LakeMissionViejo.org.

For households that are part of another HOA, that HOA determines how your delegate is elected or appointed.
