North Beach Picnic Shelters Can Now Be Reserved

Starting June 7, members can reserve space in the two North Beach picnic shelters, ensuring a spot for a special occasion like a birthday, family reunion, or team event.

Reservation Details

Rental Blocks. The shelters are rented in “blocks” costing \$150 each. Each block includes the use of half a shelter for one of the following time slots:

- 8:00 am-2:00 pm and 3:00 pm-9:00 pm.
- Reservation Limit: Each member can reserve up to two blocks per day, subject to availability. This means you can either rent half of a shelter for the entire day, or a whole shelter for half a day.

Included with each \$150 block:

- Exclusive use of ½ of a shelter.
- Five picnic tables.
- An extra-large charcoal grill.
- An advance guest list of 15 people per block reserved.

Reservation Process

Reservations can be made up to 30 days in advance at LakeMissionViejo.org/ShelterReservations.

Additional Information

- When not reserved, shelters will remain open on a first-come first-served basis but must be vacated one hour before any reservation to allow staff to prepare for the next party.
- Shelter reservations will not be available on concert or event days, holidays, or when in use by Lake-sponsored programs.

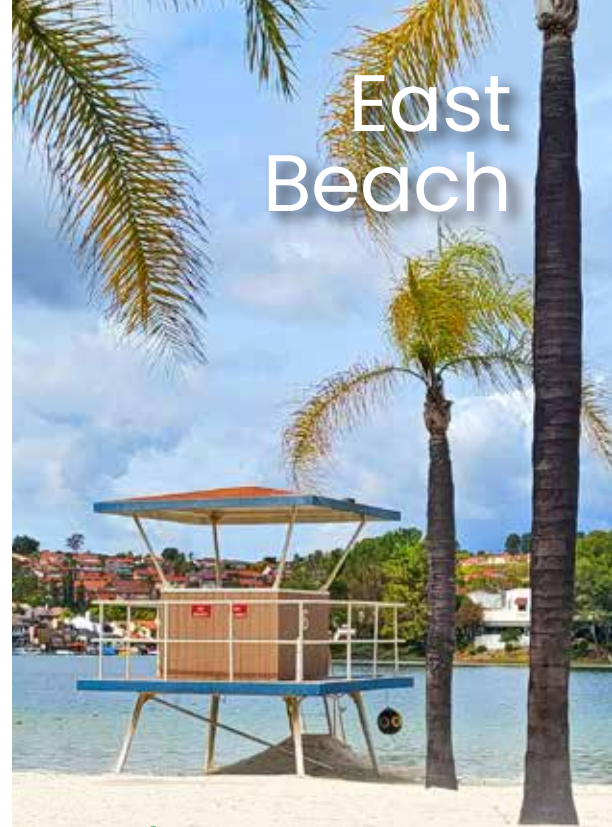

Concert FAQs

Do members need to buy a ticket? No, but a valid Lake ID badge is required for entry.

What about guests? On concert days, each member-household may host up to 4 guests at North Beach for \$20 each. Guests must arrive with the member.

How do I reserve my spot? Participate in the **optional** 6:00 am seating lottery. Please scan the QR code or use the link below to review lottery procedures before attending.

OR

Stop by the Lake the day of the concert, starting at 8:00 am, to place a blanket and chairs in any available spot.

What else do I need to know?

- Bring low beach chairs for seating.
- Blankets over 100 sq. feet and waterproof blankets/tarps are prohibited.
- Lottery participants may enter with a blanket only. Chairs and other items are permitted after completion of the lottery.
- Concert day guest pass prices apply all day for all guests at North Beach.
- No glass, personal barbeque grills, pets, or smoking permitted.
- Tents or canopies must be down by 6:00 pm.
- A drop-off zone is available before, during, and after concerts, even after the parking lot fills.
- Seating and parking are available for disabled or mobility-impaired guests.

Junior Lifeguards



Lake Mission Viejo Junior Lifeguards (JGs) is an aquatic-based education program designed for kids and teens ages 8-15.

JGs learn basic skills in open water safety, lifeguarding practices, rescue boat operations, and first-aid/responder procedures. They also participate in progressive physical fitness activities and challenges.

Additional activities JGs will enjoy include JG Olympics, an evening cookout and movie night, a visit from Orange County Fire Authority, and a graduation ceremony for family and friends to attend. JGs will also attend field trips to water parks, beaches, and the Long Beach Aquarium.

Groups and squads are organized based on age and ability, ensuring each Junior Guard is placed in the safest and most effective learning environment.



Additionally, Junior Guards ages 14-15 can try out for the Elite Squad, receiving additional responsibilities and instruction designed as a stepping stone to successful employment within the Lake Mission Viejo Lifeguard Department.

The program is available to Lake Mission Viejo member families and their sponsored guests.

Tryouts include a swim test from the shore to approximately 10 yards beyond the swim line. No flotation can be used to aid the completion of these events. Of note, parents will not be allowed to stand at or near the testing area to ensure that prospective Junior Guards enter the program with a baseline level of water confidence that ensures their safety throughout the program.

Stand-up Paddleboard fleet replacement.

The new rental boards are more stable and beginner/family friendly. They include ding-resistant technology, plus new racks and covers should increase their usable lives.

Maintenance mini trucks go electric.

This summer, be on the look-out for one of the new electric mini maintenance trucks

used on Lake facilities. These new vehicles, which replaced the older gas-powered trucks that were well past their useful life, are more environmentally friendly, less noisy, and equipped with updated safety features.

New park benches. The metal park benches at North Beach have been replaced with weather-resistant benches that match the picnic tables purchased last year.
